## General Education Courses

Courses related to

1. Health,
2. Language and information literacy,
3. Societies, cultures, and histories,
4. Economy and other human activities,
5. Human nature and ways of life

8 required courses (8 credits), 18 selective courses (out of 3 language courses, 4 credits of one language is required), 19 elective courses (34 credits), 8 credits from the designated open courses in the School of Early Childhood Education and Care



## Specialized Courses



English Communication Field	Required	27 courses (30 credits) for the general English abilities for communication
	Elective	20 courses (24 credits)
Global and Areal Studies Field	18 courses (36 credits): Courses about cultures and international relationship	
Business and Tourism Field	9 course (18 credits) about business necessary in business situations and 8 courses (16 credits) about tourism and travel business: these are interrelated with the courses on business in the area of general education.	
Literature, Linguistics, and Education field	7 literature courses (14 credits), 8 linguistics courses (16 credits), 7 education related courses (14 credits)	
Seminar & Thesis	4 Seminar courses (4 credits) and Graduation Research (4 credits)	



## Optional Courses
